So sorry to hear about your pain and exasperation. I can only sympathise and recommend that you don't have any further epidural steroid injections. It is well documented that they cause calcification and further trauma to nerves. Please go to the link below and read, especially 4.4 Special warnings and precautions for use. My " A" was caused by an injection and I refuse to have any further invasive treatments. I presume the hip replacement recall is due to a manufacturer's fault.
