An MRI caught it and almost all doctors do not know the severity of this and I have been called a pill chaser. WOW!! It came from a surgery in 2007, the scar tissue has clumped my nerves together causing pain at all times ALL TIMES!! NEVER STOPS!! I have wanted to die and to be honest if I had no children I would not waste any more time here trying to live life with this. I have moved recently and now I am searching for a doctor to work with me and have been turned down everywhere I have searched, I have been in the emergency room twice this week so far due to not able to shut the pain off for the fact that I cannot find a doctor that will write any pain meds so I will be back to the ER again, only to be told we will not deal with chronic pain at the ER room. I will have to buy street pain meds to keep myself alive until I can find an educated doctor. Sorry for the rant right now I'm upset with the whole thing.

Yes, we want your nightmare bc we all are having nightmares! But, at least you can hear another person say i know, really know what torment that you are going through, me i know & all of us know. I had aa on my MRI's since 1988-2012 & i was told in 2012! No "what" it is just "that" i had it. Its very hard & while i have no arach dr i do see a physiatrist for pain meds. I truly hope that you find help immediately!
