Hi Becky, I think our situation may have been different. The symptoms were deemed to be due to the syrinxes rather than primarily AA, although that was the most likely underlying cause. All the other AA symptoms now dominate having relieved the pressure and getting a more free flow of SF. The best

course always seems leave well alone unless really necessary. We have turned down several courses of action because of this, including further spinal investigations and pain pump. We now just do the painkilling drugs and anti cramp/muscle spasm pills rather than further intervention.
